Bonfire Permit Process

- 1. Forms may be filled out <u>online</u> or <u>downloaded</u> from the city's website and printed at home or picked up at Central Fire Station, 433 S. Main St., Lima, OH 45804-1237, between the hours of 9:00 am and 5:00 pm.
- 2. Return completed forms in person or by mail to the address listed above if not using the online form.
- 3. LFD will contact applicant within 72 hours of receiving completed application.
- 4. Permit will be validated once site is approved by LFD.
- 5. The permit holder is responsible for contacting the EPA prior to the bonfire. EPA notification and <u>permission forms</u> are available at http://www.epa.ohio.gov/dapc/general/openburning.aspx

There is NO FEE for this application or permit. Failure to obtain a permit, however, may result in a \$150.00 fine.
