

Bonfire Permit Process

1. Forms may be filled out [online](#) or [downloaded](#) from the city's website and printed at home or picked up at Central Fire Station, 433 S. Main St., Lima, OH 45804-1237, between the hours of 9:00 am and 5:00 pm.
2. Return completed forms in person or by mail to the address listed above if not using the online form.
3. LFD will contact applicant within 72 hours of receiving completed application.
4. Permit will be validated once site is approved by LFD.
5. The permit holder is responsible for contacting the EPA prior to the bonfire. EPA notification and [permission forms](#) are available at <http://www.epa.ohio.gov/dapc/general/openburning.aspx>

There is NO FEE for this application or permit. Failure to obtain a permit, however, may result in a \$150.00 fine.
