The **Lima Police Department** in community partnership with the **Lima Noon Optimist Club** and the **Lima Fire Department** are taking registrations for the **Lima Police/Optimist Safety City Summer Academy 2022**. The Safety City Summer Academy utilizes the most advanced practical hands-on child safety program in the nation: the **radKIDS Personal Empowerment Safety Education Program** (www.radkids.org). Also, the **D.A.R.E (Drug Abuse Resistance Education) Program** (www.dare.org) is a major focus during the training. - ***Weeks Available: June 6-10, June 20-24, July 18-22, July 25-29**
- * There is **no cost** for the training. **Training is paid for by the Lima Noon Optimist Club.**
- * Training sessions are fully staffed and led by Lima Police Officer Eric Mericle.
